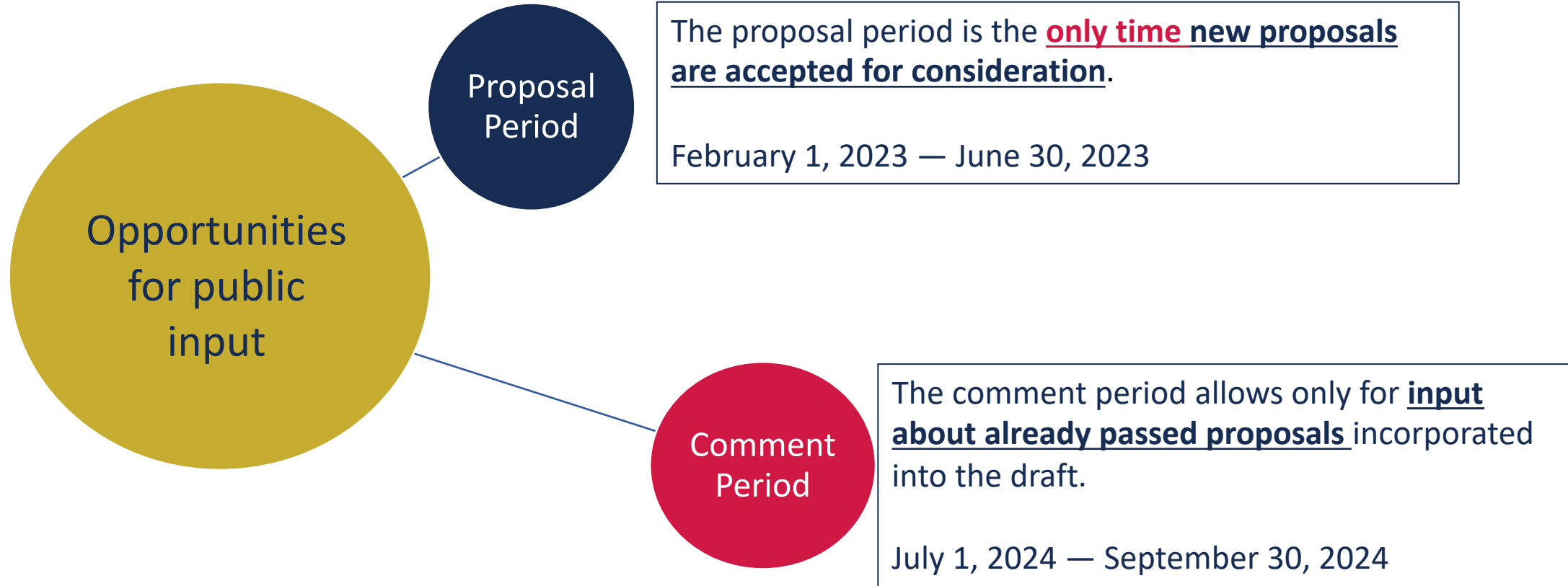
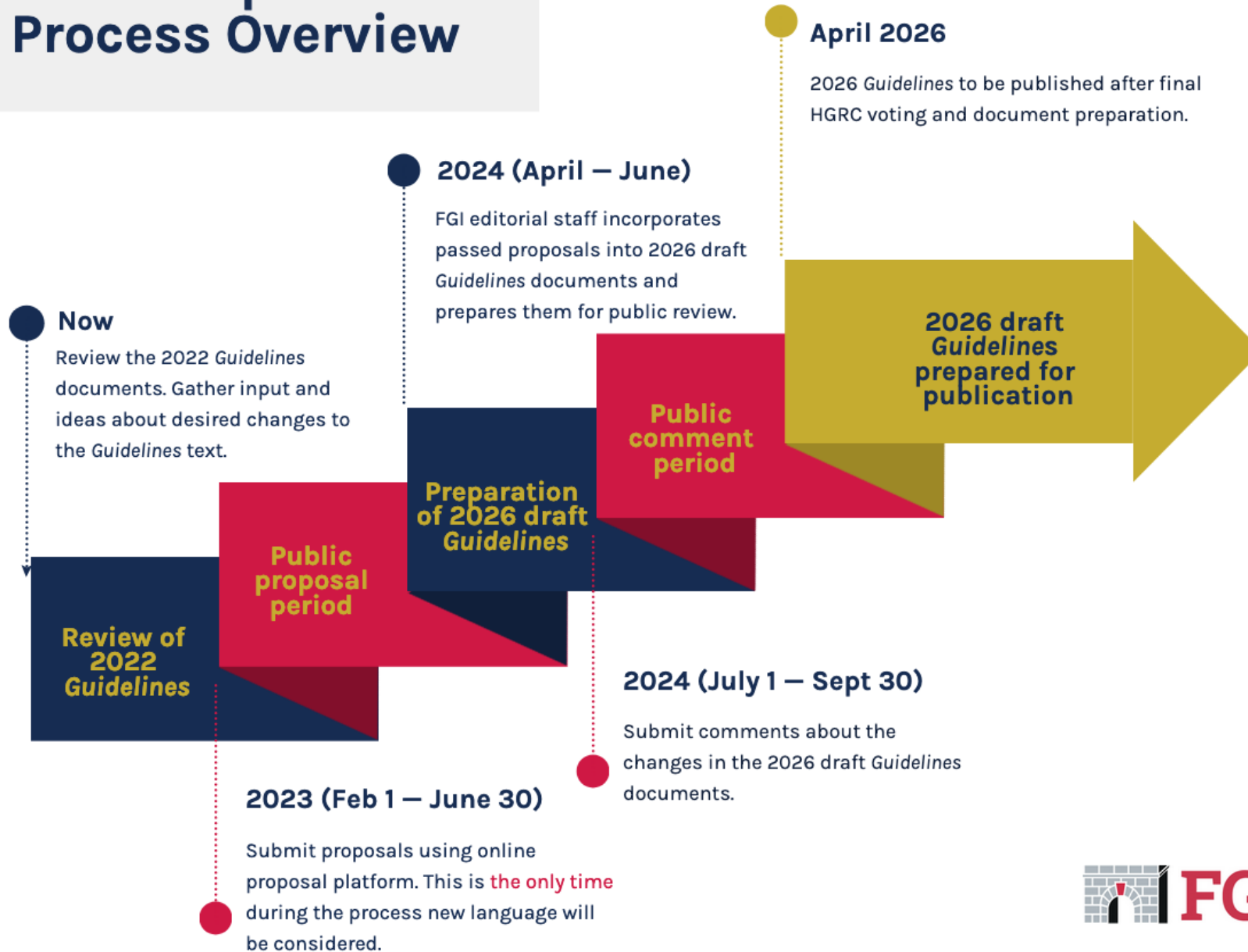


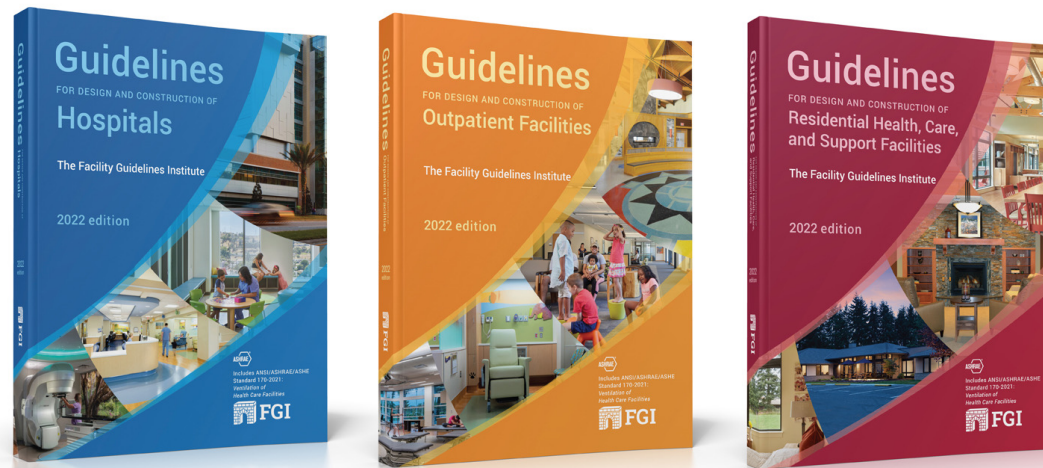

Public Input Process Overview




FGI invites you to submit

beginning **February 1, 2023.**



The proposal period **ends June 30, 2023.**

Through an **online portal**, you will be able to select any desired section of the *Guidelines* and simply delete or add text for consideration.

Health Guidelines Revision Committee.

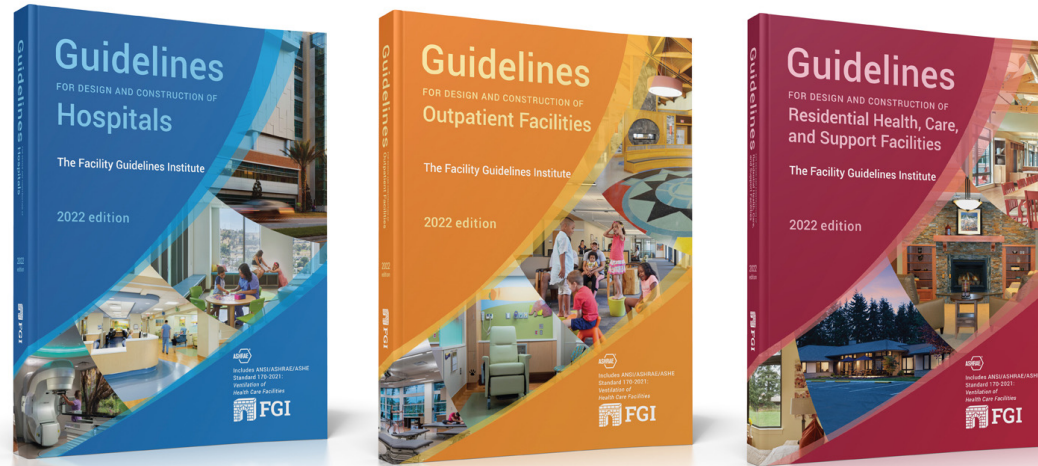


Proposals reaching a 2/3 consensus will

documents is planned for April **2026**.
